

Bankruptcy of Thomas Coleman

Dairy Manager in Bankruptcy

The statement of the affairs of Thomas Coleman, of Wylye, dairy manager, has now been issued.

He states that his liabilities amount to £115 10s. 2d., and his assets £20 14s. 0d., leaving a deficit of £94 15s. 2d.

He attributes his failure to heavy losses of cattle and horses at Fleet Farm, loss sustained on a milk contract, and losses at North Farm, Chickerill.
