On Friday se'ennight, at his lodgings at Beverley, aged 54, Mr Eyre, eldest son of the late John Eyre, D.D. of Wylye, in the county of Wilts. **Hull Packet**, **1 April 1817**

1826

Died: On Friday last, at the Rectory house, Westmeon, Hants, aged 76, the Rev. John Dampier, 50 years rector of that parish, rector of Wylye, Wilts, and prebendary of Ely **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette**, 24 August 1826

Died on the 8th instant, at his residence in Bristol, aged 64, Mr James Bennett, late of Wylye in this county; who for about 26 years held an official situation in the custom house of that city. The general features of his conduct being a suavity of manners united with sound integrity of principle, gained him the attachment and respect of all who were acquainted or had intercourse with him. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 20 November 1826**

1841

Death: On Tuesday the 5th, after a long and painful illness, borne with patience and resignation, Mr Small of Wylye, in his 49th year, deeply lamented by his family and friends. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette**, **14 January 1841**

Married: July 1, at St. Mary's Church Warwick, by the very Rev. the Dean of Hereford, the Rev. Peter Bellinger Brodie, B.A., son of P. B. Brodie, esq., of Lincoln's Inn Fields, to Isabella Octavia, youngest daughter of the late Rev. Francis Baker, Rector of Wylye, Wilts. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, 8** July 1841

Married , at Wylye, by the Rev. C. Awdry, Mr S. Foyle, of Chitterne, to Mrs E. Mead, of Wylye Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 17 June 1843

1844
