Memorial Window

A beautiful stained glass window has been placed in the church to the memory of Mr. John Waters, who was for many years churchwarden of this parish. The window depicts David in his royal robes, holding the Book of Psalms in his right hand, and a harp, studded with pearls, is standing beside him. Around his head is a scroll, with the words, "Come, ye children, and hearken unto Me," on it. The window was dedicated by the Rector after evensong on Tuesday evening, the Rev. F. W. Macdonald, of Wishford, reading the lessons. There was a fairly good congregation, among whom was Mrs. J. Waters, widow of the deceased church warden, Miss Longman, and other friends.
