In the name of God Amen On the last day of aprill in the yeare of our lord God One thousand sixe hundred ffftie five I Agnes Bleeke of Brinkworth in the County of Wilts Widdowe beinge somewhat weake of body but of perfect minde and memorie Doe make and ordayne this my last will and Testament in manner and forme followinge viz ffirst of all I give and bequeath my Soule and spirit into the hands of Almightye God And my body to be buried in the Church yeard of Brinkworth aforesaid Item I give to my sonne Anthonie Bleeke my brasse pott Item I give unto my foure Grandchildren Tenn Shillings and sixe pence a peece To be paid unto them within one moneth after my decease And all the rest of my goods My Will is that my Sonne George Bleeke shall have whom I ordaine and make my whole and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament Witnesseth my hand and Seale the day and yeare first above written The marke of Agnes Bleeke these being Witnesses *John Sherer William* ....
